Most roads under the authority of Tarbutt have been reduced to 60 km/h. Please be aware of your speed on local roads.

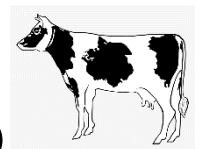

Dogs Lost or Found Call the Animal Control Officer: 705-971-6135



Please be a responsible dog owner by purchasing your annual dog tag. Proof of vaccination is required.

Annual Dog Tag Fees:
Microchipped & Spayed/Neutered - \$3
Neutered/Spayed - \$5
Not Neutered/Spayed - \$25
Kennel License - \$30
Replacement License - \$5

Leashing and Dog Tags are required every year for every dog any time they are off their own property



Tags ensure that your dog can be returned to you safely, rather than being seized and treated as a stray.

The cost to release a dog from impound is far greater than the price of a tag.

Dogs wearing tags are a sign that they are cared for and vaccinated and therefore a stranger may more likely take protective action rather than having them impounded.

REMINDER TO ALL RESIDENTS:

Pushing snow across roads and streets is not only a safety hazard, it is also against the law. The Ontario Highway Traffic Act states: No person shall deposit snow or ice on a roadway without permission in writing to do so from the Ministry or road authority responsible for maintenance of the road.

SMOKE ALARMS SAVE LIVES

- **TEST** smoke alarms monthly
- Change the **BATTERIES** twice a year
- Beware of **CHIRPING** smoke alarms – it's time to replace the batteries
- Replace older smoke alarms – **REPLACE** alarms that are more than 10 years old
- Know the **SOUND** of the smoke alarm and what to do if the alarm goes off
