ADDITIONAL  
BY-LAW NO: 20-2016**

**Being a By-Law to change the name of the Municipality**

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, C. 25, section 187. (1) *“Without limiting sections 9, 10 and 11, those sections authorize a municipality to change its name so long as the new name is not the same as the name of another municipality. 2006, c. 32, Sched. A, s. 85.”* and;

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, C. 25, section 187. (2) *“In the event of a conflict between a by-law described in subsection (1) and any provision of this or any other Act or any regulation made under any other Act, the by-law prevails. 2006, c. 32, Sched. A, s. 85.”*

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, C. 25, section 187. (3) *“A municipality that passes a by-law changing its name shall send a copy of the by-law to the Director of Titles appointed under the Land Titles Act and to the Minister promptly after its passage. 2001, c. 25, s. 187 (3).”*

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, C. 25, section 187. (4) *“By-law changing the name of a municipality does not affect the status of a municipality as an upper-tier municipality, a lower-tier municipality or a single-tier municipality, as the case may be. 2001, c. 25, s. 187 (4).”*


WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, C. 25, section 187. (5) *“A change in the name of a municipality does not affect its rights or obligations. 2001, c. 25, s. 187 (5).”*

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council, of The Corporation of the Township of Tarbutt and Tarbutt Additional does hereby propose to change the name of the municipality:
