## Dog Tag Reminder!



Dog tags must be renewed yearly on or before the 31st day of March. Leashing and dog tags are required for every dog anytime they are off their own property. Dogs wearing tags are a sign that they are cared for and vaccinated.

**Vaccination Requirement:** A certificate signed by a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine is required, and indicates that each dog has been inoculated against rabies within the last 24 months.
