## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TARBUTT

## BY-LAW 2025 - 09

## A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A MEMBER OF COUNCIL TO THE EAST ALGOMA POLICE SERVICES BOARD.

**WHEREAS** Section 5 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended states that the powers of the municipal council shall be exercised by by-law, unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to appoint certain persons to Boards and Committees to advise and represent Council on various matters under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS composition of the OPP Detachment Boards is covered under O. Reg. 135/24; and

WHEREAS the East Algoma Police Services Board is a Board under the jurisdiction of the East Algoma detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), of which each municipal council has one representative;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of The Township of Tarbutt enacts as follows:

- 1. That Councilor Jacqui Nagel, having met the qualifications and requirements of the statutes, be hereby appointed as the Tarbutt Community Representative on the East Algoma Police Services Board.
- 2. That this By-law shall be known and referred to as the "Police Services Board Appointment By-law".
- 3. That any previous by-law or resolution which conflicts with this by-law be hereby repealed.
- 4. This By-law shall take effect on the date of passing.

READ A FIRST, AND TAKEN AS READ A SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED this Nineteenth day of March, 2024.
