



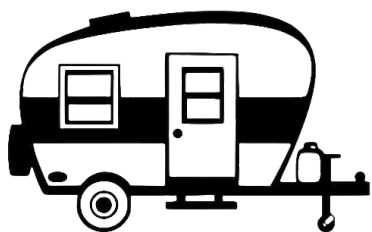

Free Fibre-to-the-Home Connection – Community Information Meeting

Fibre-to-the-home connection is coming to The Township of Tarbutt, bringing fast, reliable internet infrastructure to every residence. The physical fibre connection from the road to your home will be installed at no cost to the homeowner. Residents are invited to attend a community information session to learn what this project means for your property, how the consent process works, and what to expect during construction and installation.

Session to be hosted by PomeGran, the company building the fibre network in our community. During the session, PomeGran will outline the project timeline, explain how to provide consent for your free fibre drop, and answer questions. Residents will also have the opportunity to meet the project team.

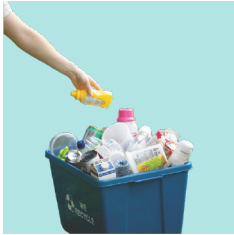

BE RECYCLE READY

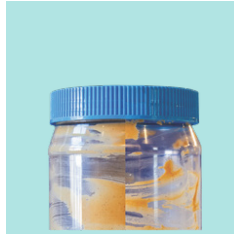
Simple steps to recycling right.

Sort
