## How to prepare Recycling



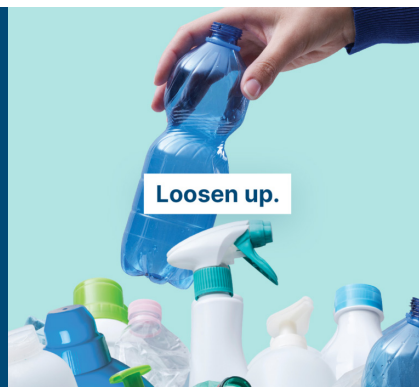
A short rinse goes a long way.

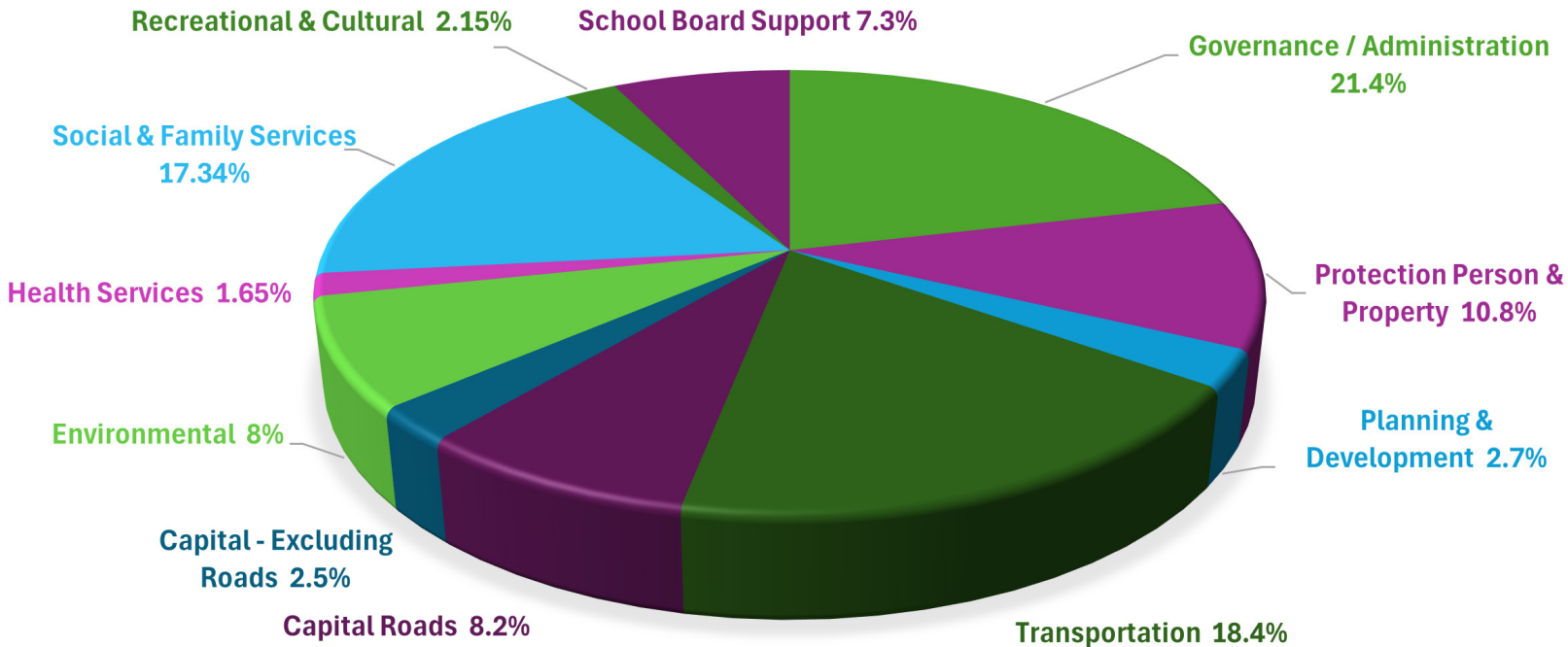

## CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS ARE NOW THE LAW

As of January 1, 2026, Carbon Monoxide (CO) Alarms are mandatory for all homes

- ✔ Install CO alarms beside all sleeping areas
- ✔ Install CO alarms on every storey of the home

### Fire Permits are required each year

- Required between April 1st and October 31
- Fire Permits are FREE
- Fines can be issued for not having a permit, burning materials other than wood and brush, and daytime burning
- Fire Permits are issued to **property owners only**
- No daytime burning is permitted without written permission of the Fire Chief
- Do not burn if winds are over 16 Km
- Keep Fire 15 metres (50') from any structure
- Keep Fire 5 metres (17') from any combustibles (trees, brush, etc.)
- Burns must not exceed 1m<sup>2</sup> (3' x 3' x 3')

### PROTECT YOUR FAMILY, INSTALL CO ALARMS TODAY!

How to prevent carbon monoxide build up in your home:

- Ensure fuel burning appliances and chimneys are inspected by professionals every year.
- Ensure outside vents and chimneys for the dryer, furnace, stove, fireplace and other fuel burning appliances are not blocked
- Never use a stove or oven to heat your home
- Never run a vehicle, fueled engine or motor inside a garage, even if the door is open.
