## How to prepare Recycling



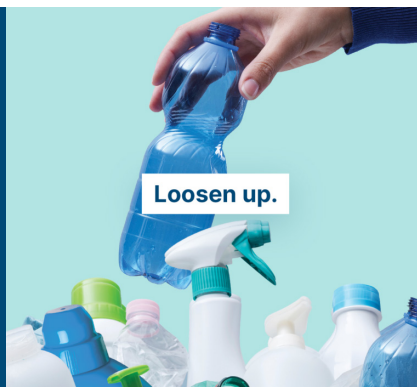
A short rinse

## Heat Warning Reminder

When Algoma Public Health issues a Heat Warning, it's a reminder that hot and humid weather can be dangerous, especially for those working outdoors, farmers, young workers, contractors, and anyone spending long hours outside.

Stay safe by drinking plenty of water, taking breaks in the shade, wearing light coloured clothing, and avoiding strenuous work during the hottest part of the day whenever possible. Be aware of signs of heat related illness, such as dizziness, headache, nausea, or confusion. Check in on older adults, neighbours, and anyone who may be more vulnerable.

Don't forget about your livestock and pets—they need access to fresh water and shade too.
